

# ATTESTATION / LEGALIZATION OF PERSONAL DOCUMENTS

**IMPORTANT:** Note that all documents for attestation or legalization must be already attested by the Indian Ministry of Foreign Affairs

## LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ATTESTATION / LEGALIZATION OF PERSONAL DOCUMENTS

- 1 A Miscellaneous application form duly filled in and signed (available on VFS website)
- 2 Original and self-attested photocopy of passport (first and last page)
- 3 Original and self-attested photocopy of Spanish resident card
- 4 Original documents to be attested along with photocopy 
  - Fees will be charged as per the number of documents to be attested or legalized
  - Attestation by Indian Ministry of Foreign Affairs must be over than 3 months old in case of PCC, and over 6 months old in case of Birth Certificate/Marriage certificate
  - Documents in Spanish must first be translated to English (by an official translator) and then attested by the Spanish Ministry of Foreign Affairs
- 5 Declaration form: to be filled by all applicants when submitting any application
