IMPORTANT: The Embassy does not issue divorce certificates. A decree of divorce can only be issued by a competent court of Law. However, if an applicant has already obtained a decree of divorce from a competent Indian court of law and got it apostilled by the Ministry of External Affairs, (Consular Division), Patiala House, New Delhi. Such apostilled documents do not require attestation from this Embassy. The Embassy will attest the seal of the Ministry if it is more than six months old.

LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR DIVORCE ATTESTATION

- 1 A Miscellaneous application form duly filled in and signed (available on BLS website)
- 2 One photograph conforming to Indian Government norms as per specifications mentioned on our website
 - A Photo service complying to the Indian norms is available in our offices
- 3 Original valid passport and photocopy of first and last pages
- 4 Photocopy of the residence card. In case applicant doesn't have residence card, photocopy of the latest "empadronamiento" is required with English translation
- 5 Original and photocopy of divorce decree
 - This document must have been apostilled by the MEA
- 6 Declaration form : to be filled in by all applicants when submitting any application
