- 4 Original and self-attested photocopy of resident card. In case applicant is not holding a resident card, Empadronamiento and English translation is required.
- 5 A letter from the civil registry of the Spanish Principalities/States concerned (or their requirements) asking for such conduct certificate to be issued by the Embassy
- 6 Declaration form : to be filled in by all applicants when submitting any application
