## LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR A JOURNALIST VISA

- 1 **Original passport valid for a minimum of 6 months (or for the validity requested, if greater) and having at least 2 blank visa pages and copy**
- 2 **Two photographs conforming to Indian Government norms as per specifications mentioned on our website** 
  - A Photo service complying to the Indian norms is available in our offices
- 3 **An Indian Government visa application form duly filled in online and signed on pages 1 and 2 (online form link: <https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa/index.html>)**
- 4 **A letter from your employer stating the purpose of your visit and duration of stay in India. This letter should be written on company letterhead and in English**
- 5 **Copy of email response received from PIC wing of Embassy of India, Madrid**
- 6 **Declaration form : to be filled by all applicants submitting any application**
- 7 **Additional documents mentioned below as per your case**

## LIST OF ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS

### **If the applicant is not holding a Spanish passport**

- Registration Certificate from the concern City Council/Municipal (minimum period of stay in Spain is 2 years), with an issue date which should not exceed 180 days.
- Referral form duly filled in Capital Letters

### **If the applicant obtained Spanish nationality by naturalization and previously held Bangladeshi, Pakistani or Sri Lankan nationality**

- Literal Birth certificate. (Certificación literal de nacimiento)
- Nationality certificate proving when Spanish nationality was obtained

### **If the applicant will participate in the filming of a documentary or commercial in India**
