

# PROJECT VISA

**IMPORTANT:** This visa category is for foreign nationals coming to India for execution of a project or contract within the scope of the Energy or Steel sector only. Not that prior approval may be required before you are able to submit your application.

**NOTE:** If you are going for project purpose then you may apply under Employment Visa category.

## LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR A PROJECT VISA

- 1 Original passport valid for a minimum of 6 months (or for the validity requested, if greater) and having at least 2 blank visa pages
- 2 Two photographs conforming to Indian Government norms as per specifications mentioned on our website 
  - A Photo service complying to the Indian norms is available in our offices
- 3 An Indian Government visa application form duly filled in online and signed on pages 1 and 2 (online form link: <https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa/index.html>)
- 4 A formal offer letter for the project work in India
- 5 A copy of your work contract with the organization India mentioning the place where you will develop the work
- 6 Additional Project Approval Form duly filled and signed
- 7 Declaration form : to be filled by all applicants submitting any application
- 8 Additional documents mentioned below as per your case

## LIST OF ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS

### If the applicant is not holding a Spanish passport

- Registration Certificate from the concern City Council/Municipal (minimum period of stay in Spain is 2 years), with an issue date which should not exceed 180 days.
- Referral form duly filled in Capital Letters

### If the applicant obtained Spanish nationality by naturalization and previously held Bangladeshi, Pakistani or Sri Lankan nationality

- Literal Birth certificate. (Certificación literal de nacimiento)
- Nationality certificate proving when Spanish nationality was obtained
